Meeting was called to order at 7:05pm

Richard Huth was asked to leave as he was no longer a member.

Pledge of Allegiance/Prayer

Same update on the Lincoln Dinner was given as in the Executive Minutes.

REMINDER: September 17th Constitution Day meet at Pizza Ranch in Baraboo.

Annual Caucus date of February 15th was announced. Announcement was made that we need a new Treasurer before the end of the year so members will consider taking the position.

Discussion was held on the importance of running for local school board positions in Spring. There are 3 openings in Mauston and New Lisbon and 2 openings in the school districts of Necedah, Royall and Wonewoc/Union Center. Mike Berger is running in Necedah but we need candidates for other districts.

Discussion was held to report on the Juneau County Board trying to appoint a County Administrator. That person would be above the county board making decisions and taking away power from the board members elected by residents. October 2nd is a budget meeting for the Juneau County Board. It is an important meeting to attend at the courthouse at 10am.
